

## **Motion to Commit With Instructions**

Mr. SCOTT of South Carolina moves to commit the bill H.R. 5376 to the Committee on Finance of the Senate with instructions to report the same back to the Senate in 3 days, not counting any day in which the Senate is not in session, with changes that—

1           (1) are within the jurisdiction of such com-  
2           mittee;

3           (2) eliminate additional Internal Revenue Serv-  
4           ice funding for enforcement; and

5           (3) establish a child opportunity tax credit for  
6           individuals that—

7                   (A) addresses the learning loss of students  
8                   as a result of prolonged school closures; and

9                   (B) does not result in a projected revenue  
10           loss over the 10-year budget window of more  
11           than \$45,637,400,000.
